2010 Paint, Sculpt, Shoot: The Four Seasons

Hello Artists!

Last year we tried something new for our annual event, **Paint, Sculpt, Shoot**, by hosting events throughout the year to encourage artists to create from the landscape in all four seasons. As a result, we were proud to host the most diverse plein air exhibition we've ever had with everything from snow scenes to flowers. We are excited to announce our plans for the **5th Annual Paint, Sculpt, Shoot: The Four Seasons**. There are a few small changes so please read through the information carefully.

This is a great opportunity for beginner and advanced plein air artists to get together in and around beautiful Evergreen and create from the landscape. We invite artists in all mediums, including traditional *en plein air* painting and other approaches to the landscape, to participate. This event is a true collaboration between participating artists, CAE, the Evergreen galleries, the downtown merchants, and location hosts to inspire and educate the community about the process of making art.

Paint, Sculpt, Shoot: The Four Seasons will consist of four events, plus an exhibition, with following schedule:

- **Winter Event: Paint the Lake – Friday, February 26th 10am-3pm**
With the help of our good friends, the Evergreen Parks and Recreation District, we have special use of the Evergreen Lake House for this event. They will give us access to the rotunda and other inside areas, as well as the surrounding porches, patios, and grounds for a day of creating works of art from the winter landscape. Artists are encouraged to bring a sack lunch; drinks and snacks will be provided.
- **Spring Event: Quick Create and Critique – Saturday, May 15th 9am-4pm**
We are bringing back this event here at CAE, but with a new addition. At the end of the day, we will have a critique in the gallery so you can get feedback about your creations. Artists will be invited to create works of art around CAE, Buchanan Park, Elk Meadow, and the surrounding areas from 9am-2pm. We will provide drinks and snacks and we ask participating artists to bring a sack lunch. Susiehyer, an accomplished, award-winning plein air painter and instructor, will facilitate the group critique from 2-4pm.
- **Summer Event: Paint, Sculpt, "Shoot Out" – Saturday, July 24th 9am-4pm**
Celebrate Evergreen in the summer, inside and out, by creating works of art throughout the downtown area. Evergreen will be filled with visitors who will be attending the Evergreen Jazz Festival, and we wanted to capitalize on the visibility associated with this popular event. The downtown businesses will provide lunch for the artists and will open their doors for artists to create inside as well.

- **Fall Event: Create with a View – Saturday, September 11th 9am-4pm**
We are exploring a new location this year to capture the early fall landscape. Join us at Mt. Falcon Park in Indian hills where historic sites like the Walker Home Ruins and scenic vistas of Denver, Red Rocks Park, and more await. The Mt. Falcon trail system provides plenty of inspiration. The park has restrooms and picnic tables near the west parking area, and we will provide lunch and drinks from the covered picnic area.

- **Paint, Sculpt, Shoot: The Four Seasons Exhibition – September 24th through October 16th, 2010**
This juried exhibition will be open to all works of art created from the landscape (no studio work except for finishing up work started outside) from October 2009 through September 2010, even those created outside of the scheduled events. **However, to be included in the exhibit you must participate in at least one of the scheduled events.** Each participating artist will be allowed to submit up to five works of art for consideration. Everyone is guaranteed between one and three pieces in the exhibit, with the remainder of the pieces being used for a live auction during the Opening Reception. Artists will receive their usual commission on pieces sold in the auction. **A juror will select the work for the exhibition and award fabulous cash prizes in several categories.** More information about the exhibit will be sent later to artists who have registered for one or more of the events. (Note: we will not stamp or date work, however we are relying on the honor system that all works of art in the exhibition will be created from the landscape in the stated time frame).

The events are designed to give our community of artists a day of camaraderie and an opportunity to create together and learn from each other in a special setting. Some events will include a lunch, while others will require the artists to bring a sack lunch – this will be reflected in the fee. In case of extreme inclement weather, we will attempt to arrange alternate dates.

To participate in this exciting annual event, please fill out the enclosed entry form and remit the appropriate fees. Artists are responsible for their own transportation and lodging. Registered artists will receive event logistics via e-mail before each event.

We look forward to watching you create works of art that celebrate the beautiful landscape of the mountain community.
